John has diverse experience working internationally in major asset management, commercial and business development, project management, shipping/maritime, IT and supply chain, primarily in the oil and gas sector.

John is currently an independent consultant having retired from Shell (RDS) at the beginning of 2017 where he was VP for Global supply chain with commercial oversight of a significant annual Shell Group spend, based in The Hague.

He was previously General Manager of Shell Trading and Supply in London. John was responsible for the Shell group vessel management services, with direct responsibility for all the oil tankers, LNG, LPG carriers and one FPSO operated by Shell for various Shell companies and joint ventures in Qatar, Nigeria, Brunei and Australia. The fleet included over 70 vessels and global staff of over 3,700. Responsibilities also included vessel safety, security and emergency response function for chartered and operated vessels trading worldwide.

John was Board Director and Chair of Shell Ship Management LTD, Shell Tankers Australia and Trident Services LTD as well as Board Director of Shell Tankers UK. He started his career with Exxon Shipping in various engineering, project management, supply chain and IT positions, before joining the American Bureau of Shipping and becoming the VP for Europe, Africa and the Middle East. Prior to joining Shell, he was Senior VP of Marine Operations with Royal Caribbean Group in Miami for a fleet of cruise vessels under the Celebrity Cruises, Azamara Cruises and TUI Cruises brands where he was also Director of Grand Bahamas Shipyard and Board member of the Community Partnership for the Homeless.

John received his MBA from Michigan State University (Supply Chain) and his Bachelor in Engineering (Naval architecture) from State University in New York. He is a Registered Professional Engineer (Mich) and licensed as Chief Engineer (USCG). He was also a Lieutenant in the US Naval Reserve.
